P.G. Department of Botany

Post Graduate Department of Botany was established in the year 1915. The Department is currently running UG, PG programmes and various courses in collaboration with other faculties. The Botanical Society of the Department organizes inter-college flower show every year. It also organizes various awareness rallies regarding social and environmental issues. Department regularly organizes seminars, workshops, extension lectures and competitions to upgrade the student's knowledge and skill. The laboratories are well equipped with recent scientific instrumentation. The department maintains a rich botanical garden which has more than 350 species of cryptogams, gymnopserms and angiosperms.

AQHH-2022:

This National Conference is being organized by Post Graduate Department of Botany, Khalsa College, Amritsar in collaboration with Punjab Pollution Control Board, Patiala under National Clean Air Programme of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MOEFCC), Govt. of India. National Green Tribunal (NGT) has directed MOEFCC to modify the CAP which proposes 20-30% reduction of air pollution by 2024.

NCAP: Introduction and Key Point:

It was launched by the MoEFCC, Govt. of India in January 2019. It is the first-ever effort in the country to frame a national framework for air quality management with a time-bound reduction target. It seeks to cut the concentration of coarse (particulate matter of diameter 10 micrometer or less, or PM10) and fine particles (particulate matter of diameter 2.5 micrometer or less, or PM2.5) by at least 20% in the next five years, with 2017 as the base year for comparison. This plan of NCAP includes 102 non-attainment cities, across 23 states and Union territories, which were identified by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on the basis of their ambient air quality data between 2011 and 2015. Non-attainment cities: These are those that have fallen short of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for over five years.

Call for Abstracts and Papers

The delegates are requested to submit their original research contributions in any of the thrust areas of the conference. Only soft copies of abstract (Max. 250 words) formatted on MS Word (A4 size) in Times New Roman, font size 10, in single line spacing with 2.5 cm margins on all sides, be submitted by 25-09-2022. The abstract may be sent through electronic mail at aqhh2022@gmail.com. The name of all the authors should be given as full and presenting author should be underlined.

Young Environmentalist Award

A special session for the "Young Environmentalist Award" will be held during the conference. The participants upto 35 years of age as on 14-10-2022 may submit their full length papers at aqhh2022@gmail.com on or before 30-09-2022. Papers submitted under this category shall be scrutinized by technical expert committee and only best papers will be allowed for presentation. Each participant will be given 20 minutes for presentation followed by 5 minutes for discussion.

Best Poster Presentation Award

There will be three "Best Poster Awards" in the conference. For poster presentation, the poster dimensions should be 24" x 36".

Best Oral Presentation Award

There will be three "Best Oral Awards" in the conference. Each participant will be given 10 minutes for presentation followed by 5 minutes for discussion.

The scientists, R&D professionals, faculty, research scholars & experts from educational Institutions, government & non-government organizations etc. are invited in the conference.
